




Technical Data

ENGINE: 40 cubic inch o.h.v. high compression twin; vachrome top piston rings; heavy duty crankshaft forged from maganese-molybdenum steel; new heavy duty main bearing. Light alloy connecting rods with replaceable inserts; gear driven sports type camshaft; mechanical crankcase breather; magneto ignition with automatic advance. Large bore Amal carburetor with air cleaner. Engine is set up to produce maximum horsepower, and high performance, with extremely good reliability.

FRAME: Ariel double tube frame, welded by special process into one strong unit. Telescopic front forks, swinging arm rear suspension, both with hydraulic shock absorbers.

TRANSMISSION: Burman heavy duty four speed gear box with visual gear position indicator; Burman heavy duty clutch. Optional at slight extra cost is complete rear chain enclosure with automatic chain lubrication system.

FINISH AND EQUIPMENT: Bright red and jet black two tone tank with white striping and chrome trim. Chrome plated fenders and braces, black frame. Handlebars, wheel rims, exhaust system, levers and many other parts are finished in heavy chrome or highly polished alloy. Equipment includes luxurious dualseat, passenger footrests, jiffy stand, center stand, and front wheel stand, steering head lock, western type handlebars, complete tool kit and tire pump.
