These models have been greatly improved. A modified design of cylinder head, cylinder and piston ensure better performance and more refined, quiet running.

All Lion models are fitted with the new Sunbeam patent decompressor.

The above model is specially tuned at an extra cost of £10 for racing. This model cannot be fitted with Lucas magdyno lighting set, electric horn, or rear chaincase.

Speed approximately 90-92 m.p.h. with silencer and fishtall fitted, using 50/50 petrol-benzol mixture.

When tuned for racing with straight through exhaust pipe the speed is approximately 96 m.p.h.



REMOVABLE CARRIER. This illustration shows pillion seat and tool bag which are supplied when carrier top is not required.








BRAKE DRUM can be detached from front wheel by removal of three screws.


Model 9. This sidecar is of elegant appearance and is constructed on the latest scientific pressed steel principle. This method has made it possible to produce a sidecar of beauty and strength at a very low price.

The top panels are deeply louvred, sweeping with distinctive grace from nose to tail.

The standard colour available is All Black with optional colours as follows: Black body with Signal Red louvres; Green body with Ivory louvres; Red body with Ivory louvres; lvory body with Black louvres.
